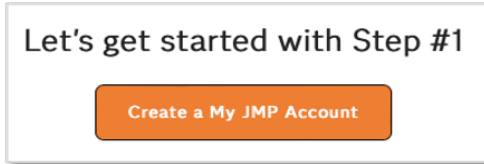
Follow these 6 Steps to get started with JMP

- 2 Tell us about your Studies**
Now that you have successfully created your My JMP ID, tell us your course name, academic institution, and affiliation. Submit the form to get to the next step.
- 3 Authenticate**
Select your school/university from the list and provide your login credentials as usual. No data will be transmitted, we just receive a notification that your login was successful.
- 4 Checkout**
Given that you were able to authenticate, you are now entitled to order the free JMP Student Edition. The \$0 product has already been added to your shopping cart. All you need to do is to click the "Checkout" button.
- 5 Complete Checkout**
Continue with the checkout process and provide your shipping address, confirm the subscription agreement, and order your JMP Student Edition. You're almost there, you just have to click the "Place Order" button!
- 6 Download, Install, and Activate**
Allow up to ten minutes for us to set your permissions. After this, go to the [Software License](#) section of your JMP Store account and follow the guidance on how to download and activate the software.

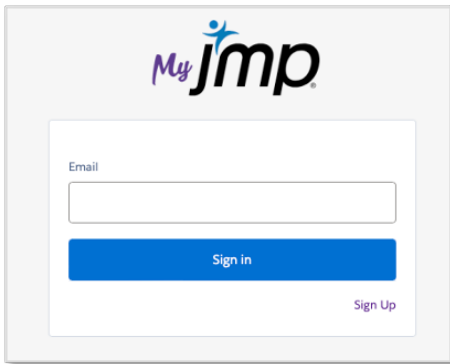

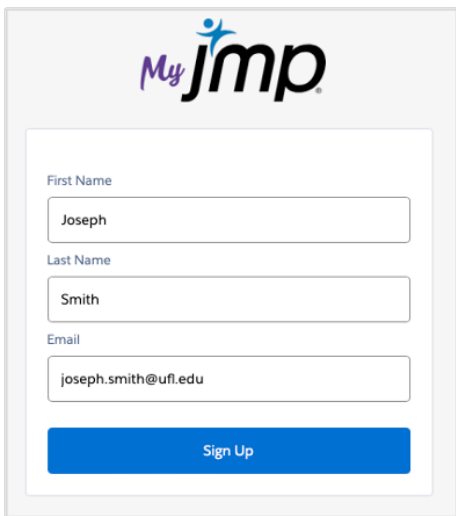
- 1a. Select to create a My JMP Account.




- 1b. Choose Sign Up to create a My JMP account. If you already have an account, enter email.

Note: You need to use your email address from your academic institution.




- 1d. Enter Verification Code sent to your email.

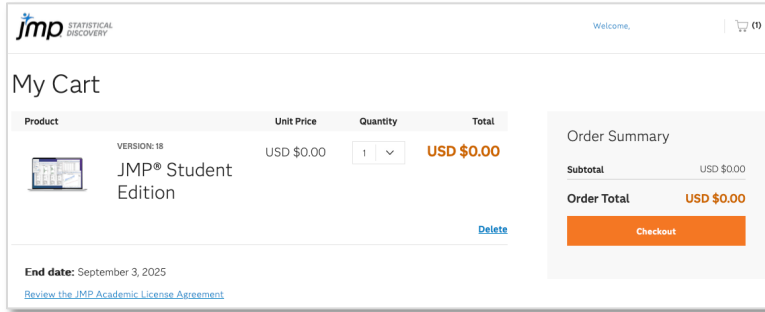

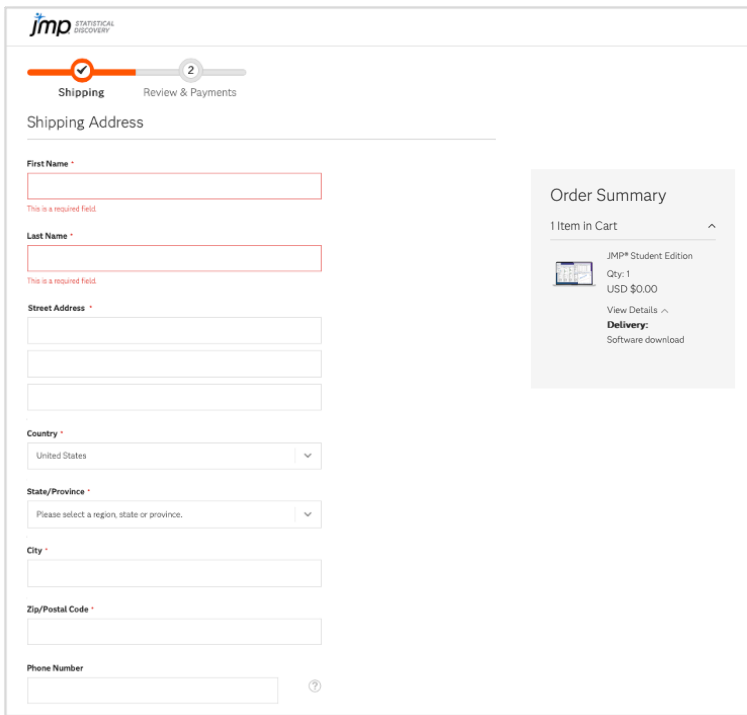

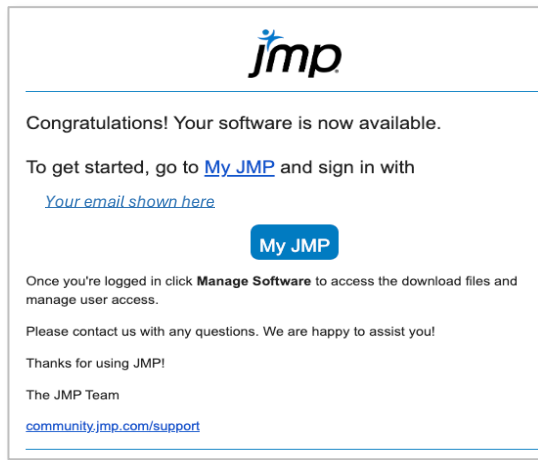

- 6d. Select the “JMP Student Edition” icon.



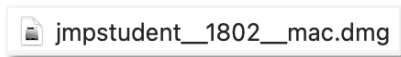
- 6e. Final Installation Instructions will be shown. Choose to download version for your Operating System.

Depending upon the speed of your internet connection, this may take a few minutes. The file will appear in your Downloads folder.

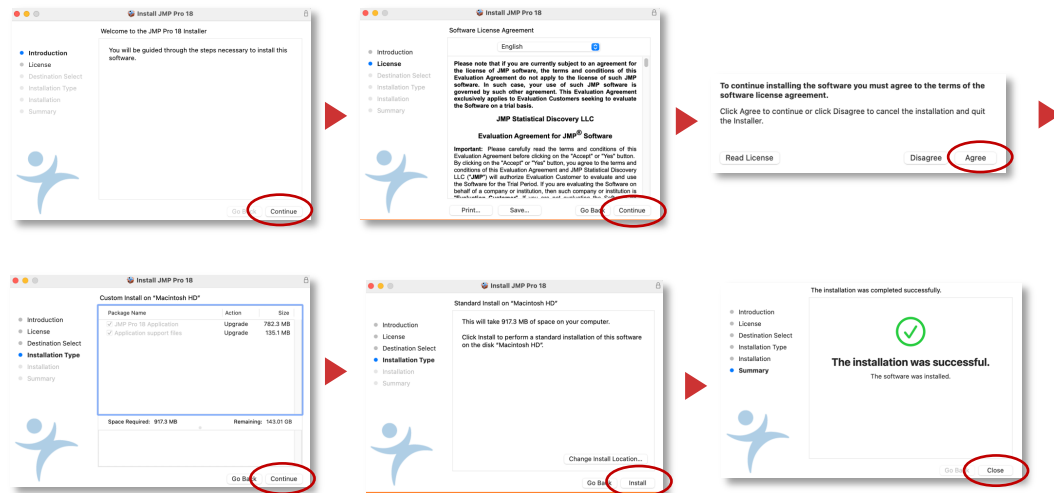


- MAC 2.** Open the JMP Installer by double-clicking on the file.

- MAC 4.** Follow the steps to install JMP® Student Edition by selecting Continue, Install, and then Close when completed.



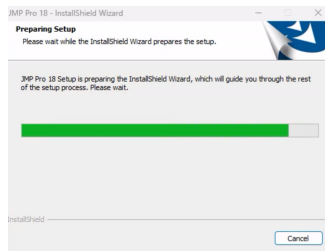
INSTALLING JMP® STUDENT EDITION FOR WINDOWS OPERATING SYSTEM

Depending upon the speed of your internet connection, this may take a few minutes. The file will appear in your Downloads folder.

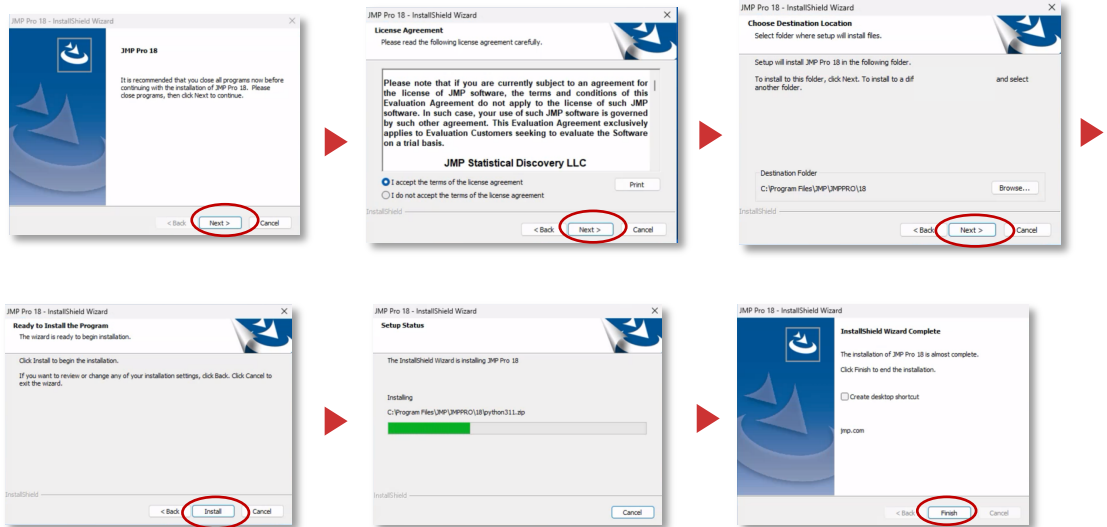


WIN2. Open the JMP Installer by double-clicking on the file.

WIN4. Follow the steps to install JMP® Student Edition by selecting Next, Install and then Finish when completed.

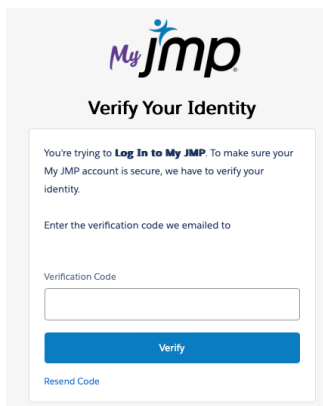


OPENING JMP® STUDENT EDITION
