Later, he shared his insights regarding the decision-making criteria, integrated risk management, and strategic alliances during the procurement process. He ended the session on the note – how a balanced functional and behavioural attitude is important to fit into the new paradigm of complex management.





Guest Lecture on Multi-Modal Transportation

Sigmato club got the opportunity to host Mr. Deepak Ghatole, Sr. DGM – Strategic Logistics, TAFE Ltd, for delivering a guest lecture on "Multi-Modal Transportation" on 1st December 2019. He started the session by talking about supply chain management and how new-age technology is playing a massive role in changing the conventional ways of SCM. He explained the consequences of 'Silo Working' in which he emphasized the importance of horizontal and vertical integration within and outside the organization. He also shared the significance of multimodal versus intermodal operations and highlighted the upcoming challenges of continuously evolving supply chain management. In the end, he talked about prevalent networks of multimodal transportation in India and how TAFE is leveraging it for the promotion of unconventional growth in the agriculture sector.







Lean Six Sigma – Green Belt Training Program
